



Prayer Letter for May 2024

BIBLE PASSAGE:

Micah 2:1-5 *'I will surely gather the remnant all of you, O Jacob. I will put them together like sheep of the fold, like a flock in the midst of their pasture, they shall make a loud noise because of so many people.'*

Micah's messages were directed chiefly towards Jerusalem and Samaria, the destruction and then future restoration of the Judean state, and he rebuked the people of Judah for dishonesty and idolatry. His main message was about destruction and restoration.

Micah teaches his people that living justly, loving mercy, and following the Lord are more important than sacrifices and offerings. Micah testifies that Jehovah is compassionate and forgives the sins of those who repent.

As we condemn all these happenings, we rest on God's assurance and promise as proclaimed by Micah that there will be restoration and that finally peace will reign across the nations and the world.

Lord in your mercy we ask for peace to reign in our homes, families and especially across the world. We pray o Lord that you will reign in the hearts of men and cause the war between Israel and Gaza to come to an end. This is our request to you Lord and we asked in the name of your son our Saviour Jesus Christ Amen!
